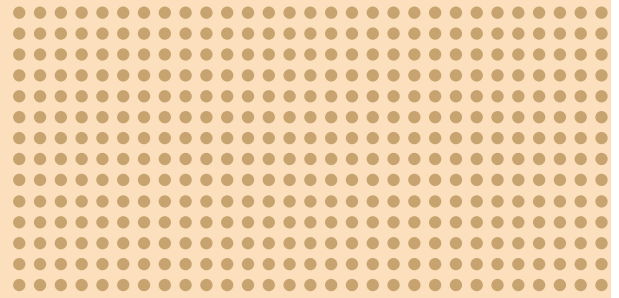

Background

A well-managed supply chain of vaccines is the most fundamental step for ensuring safety of the vaccines. As the complexity in the vaccination programme are increasing day by day, healthcare professionals should be able to provide solutions to the managerial and operational challenges in supply chain management of vaccines namely vaccine handling, stock management, minimizing vaccine wastages, handling emergency situations, storage, and distribution etc.

Cold chain management is the most crucial and inherent component of supply chain which determines the potency, safety, and efficacy of the vaccines and should be properly addressed at each delivery point of supply chain of vaccines.

A well-executed vaccines management programme addressing the intricacies of cold chain is the need of the hour to resolve the bottlenecks and to build the trust of the public in the health system of the country.

Objectives Of The Programme

The programme will provide the participants with the tools and techniques for effectively managing the supply chain of vaccines with added focus to the cold chain management thus ensuring the safety of the vaccines. They will be exposed to real situation to help them to find the practical solutions and implement them in their own settings.

Duration And Venue

- The programme is of one-week duration. The programme will start in the morning of Monday, 20th April 2020 and will conclude at evening on Friday, 24th April, 2020. The programme is scheduled to be held at IIHMR University, Jaipur, India

Certification

- A certificate of participation on completion of the programme will be issued by IIHMR University, Jaipur.

Programme Fee

- Indian Nationals: Rs 37,500 per participant plus 18% GST
- Foreign Nationals: USD 700 per participant plus 18% GST

The fees cover tuition fees, training material, stay in air-conditioning room (twin-sharing basis), breakfast, lunch, dinner, tea/coffee during the programme and pick-up and drop from Jaipur airport/railway station/bus stand. Welcome dinner and short-trip to historical and cultural importance places in Jaipur would be offered by the University in honor of the participants. Participants would be encouraged to use library facilities. Around the clock internet facility (Wi-Fi) is available for the participants.

The travel tickets from the country of origin to Jaipur and vice versa and visa processing charges are to be borne by the participant/sponsoring agency.

Discounts On The Fee

Early Bird Discount: Nominations received with payments on/before 4-weeks (23rd March 2020) will be entitled to an early bird discount of 10%.

Group Discount: Any organization sponsoring four or more participants to the programme will be entitled for a discount of 20% on the total fee payable provided that at least four participants attend the programme.

Maximum Discount: Organization can avail themselves of both the discount subject to maximum discount of 20%.

The programme fee could be deposited online or through DD in favor of "IIHMR University", payable at Jaipur.
