

Iterative

SAGE Policy recommendations on the use of COVID-19 vaccines once authorized

September 2020

COVAX industry consultation, jointly convened by UNICEF, PAHO and Gavi

Allocation and shipments

December 2020 Dry run of allocation process

November - December 2020

Pooled tender for COVID-19 vaccines issued jointly by UNICEF and PAHO

June-July 2020

Expression of Interest (EOI) to understand manufacturing plans; market assessment developed


August 2020

Appointment of UNICEF to lead COVAX procurement for the 92 AMC countries, in collaboration with PAHO, as well as Procurement Coordinator for all COVAX Buyers, including self-financing countries


April - June 2020 Design of the COVAX Facility and AMC

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UNICEF'S PROCUREMENT COORDINATOR ROLE



UNICEF as Procurement Coordinator for the COVAX Facility (part I)



Compile information on **incoming supply from COVAX portfolio**, pressure test/assess/validate, and provide information to inform the allocation mechanism:

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
 Manufacturers to inform of projected and actual quantities of vaccine for allocation (batch numbers, remaining shelf life, number of secondary boxes) across

i) total quantities in stock pending NRA releaseli) total quantity in stock with NRA release (if any)

 To be provided by week for the immediate 4 (four) weeks; and by month for 2021, to be updated on a weekly basis to the Procurement Coordinator of the COVAX Facility

UNICEF as Procurement Coordinator for the COVAX Facility (part II)

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Monitor usage/draw down of Advance Purchase Commitments through monthly reporting.


Manufacturers to provide/COVAX Buyers to provide

 an overview of pending purchase orders, name of buyer and receiving country (batch numbers and number of secondary boxes, which shall be consistent with confirmed allocations under the Allocation Mechanism)

li) an overview of quantities delivered since the last weekly report

UNICEF as Procurement Coordinator for the COVAX Facility (part III)

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Provide support to and alignment between self-procuring countries on Summary Terms & Conditions and supporting consistency towards manufacturers

Co-convene a Procurement Reference Group to guide on commercial terms


Provide information to stakeholders and general public on progress on delivery of vaccines

UNICEF COVID-19 Vaccine Market Dashboard

The <u>COVID-19 Vaccine Market Dashboard</u> is a dynamic tool for countries, partners and industry to follow the developments of the rapidly evolving COVID-19 vaccine market and the efforts of the COVAX Facility to ensure fair and equitable access for every country in the world.

In this first release, the dashboard provides a regularly updated overview of the global **R&D pipeline**, the projected **production capacity**, publicly announced **bilateral and multilateral supply agreements**, as well as reported **price points**.

In a next phase, the dashboard will be expanded to provide visibility on progress towards the <u>COVAX Facility</u> goal of securing 2 billion vaccine doses by the end of 2021 and update on the status of procurement by UNICEF and other buyers participating in the COVAX Facility.


The initial target of COVAX is to deliver at least 2 billion doses of COVID-19 vaccine by the end of 2021 At least 97 self-financing economies (estimated range from 550-950 million doses)

Buffer for humanitarian use (100 million doses)


As country participation in the COVAX Facility is firmed up, these demand forecasts will continue to be refined and the latest estimates will be communicated in due course
